HOME TOUR: GNOSIS, LTD. At Home with Design

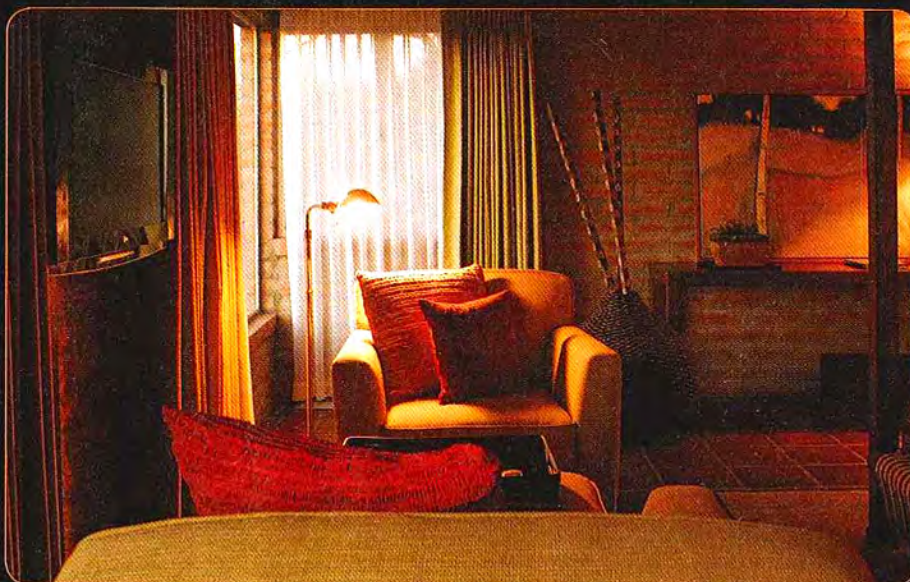
